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Luna is minimalistic and functional design at its core. Created last year by Alexander Lervik, who has been fascinated by lighting as a key element in a number of his projects. Luna is the ultimate globe lamp that doesn't cast any shadows, it's just pure uninterrupted light. The whole hanging solution is inside the globe. If you feel like the pure moonlight of Luna needs a stronger graphic expression you can add the Kosmos hanger.

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The series was born in 2015 with a desk, which evolved into a dining table and now has a few younger siblings. These tidy little tables are easy to place for presenting vignettes, green plants, or to use as desks or for the purpose of your choice. The simple concept is based on trestles, which were originally intended to achieve the proper height in work tables for craftspeople. The Arco series is now complete, with versatile tables featuring tall or short trestle legs.

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We never thought that we were to design the scent of a room, until we met the Japanese designer Takafumi Nemoto at the furniture fair in Cologne, one year ago. He showed a scented poetic sculpture in shape of a Bonsai tree.

The market is literally flooded with home fragrances, but nothing like this. Design House Stockholm, developed just one fragrance. It doesn't spread like a heavy perfume just the sense of a newly aired room with an open window overlooking a woodland lake. The gracefully hand-tied tree shaped rattan sticks are placed in a lidded vase made in stoneware and spreads the scent of Scandinavian design for a long time.

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When Mathieu Gustafsson began exploring rattan projects over five years ago, not many people were working with the material. More designers have now discovered the strong, beautiful properties of rattan. Mathieu's collected experiences from Air and his collaboration with Design House Stockholm have led to two new cabinets, which distinguish themselves depending on the application. The low bench is intended as a TV stand, but it is equally elegant as a storage cabinet, or why not as a hallway piece? Cabinet is an updated vitrine or cocktail cabinet on tall legs, which works beautifully whether in the dining room or home office.




