## PRODUKTINFORMATION

Af naturlige grunde er Danmark et af de steder i verden, hvor vi går mest op i lys. Når det er mørkt udenfor, værdsætter vi lyset indenfor. For dansk design har lamper – og måske især loftslamper – været noget af det, vi har et særligt forhold til. Den lille Hiti loftslampe er et helt nyt og forfriskende bud på, hvordan denne tradition for lampedesign ser ud i dag. Formen er rund og organisk, og i kraft af den lidt fladtrykte facon, ser den lidt anderledes ud fra hver ny vinkel. Lampen fungerer som en enkeltlampe, fx over et lille bord, eller ophængt i en serie over et større område. Den fås både i en mat opal hvid og i en helt transparent udgave.

Hiti lamperne er skabt med blik for dansk designtradition, som delvist kommer udefra. Det kommer fra Philip Bro, som er født i Australien, men har boet i Danmark det meste af sit liv. Med en legende og ukonventionel tilgang til dansk design, har han arbejdet med nogle af de mest kendte design brands.

Hiti-serien er FDB Møblers første lamper.

Vi anbefaler, at man aftørrer sin lampe med en antistatisk støveklud.

Snavsede overflader aftørres med en hårdt opvredet klud, der er skyldet i vand med lidt klart flydende opvaskemiddel.

Der skal omgående tørres efter med en ren, tør klud.

Brug ikke skarpe genstande såsom stive børster, svampe eller ståluld, når lampen rengøres.

Glas- og metalpendler kan med fordel aftørres med en fugtig klud.

## PRODUCT INFORMATION

For obvious reasons, Denmark is one of the places in the world where people take the keenest interest in light and lighting. When it's dark outside, we really value the lighting in our homes and workplaces. When it comes to Danish design, lamps – and perhaps pendants in particular – have always played a special role. The small Hiti pendant is a new and refreshing example of how the Danish tradition for lamp design is evolving today. The shape is round and organic, and given its gently flattened shape, the lamp looks slightly different from every angle. The lamp works well as a single lamp, for example over a small table, or suspended in a series over a larger area. It is available in both matt opal white and in a completely transparent version.

The Hiti lamps are inspired by Danish design traditions, but with some foreign influences. For example from Philip Bro, who was born in Australia, but who has lived in Denmark for most of his life. Taking a playful and unconventional approach to Danish design, he has worked with some of the most well-known design brands.

Hiti-series is FDB Møblers first lamps.

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

We recommend wiping the lamp using an antistatic dusting cloth.

Wipe dirty surfaces using a cloth dipped in water with a small amount of clear liquid detergent added, and then firmly wrung out.

Dry immediately afterwards using a clean, dry cloth.

Do not use harsh objects such as stiff brushes, sponges or steel wool to clean the lamp.

Preferably use a damp cloth to wipe glass and metal pendants.



FDB Møbler is manufactured using only FSC-certified wood. FSC certification ensures that no more trees are felled than the forest can reproduce. At the same time, the FSC label guarantees that forest animals and plants are protected, and that the forest workers receive training, safety equipment and a reasonable pay.
